

Positive Citizenship / No Bullying Contract

School Policy

"*Bullying*" means any severe or pervasive physical or verbal act or conduct, including communication in writing or means of electronic act, and including one or more acts committed by a pupil or group of pupils as defined in Section 48900.2, 48900.3, or 48900.4, directed toward one or more pupils that has or can be predicted to have the effect of one or more of the following:

1. Placing a reasonable pupil or pupils in fear of harm to that pupil's or those pupils' person or property.
2. Causing a reasonable pupil to experience a substantially detrimental effect on his/her physical or mental health.
3. Causing a reasonable pupil to experience a substantial interference with her/her academic performance.
4. Causing a reasonable pupil to experience a substantial interference with his/her ability to participate in or benefit from the services, activities, or privileges provided by a school.

Bullying also includes:

- Sexual harassment- using sexual language or implying sexual situations
- Hate violence- violence motivated by identity
- Intimidation- make someone do or don't do something out of fear
- Threats- an expression of an intention to inflict pain, injury, evil, or punishment

I have read the school policy regarding bullying and understand that, by my actions and/or words, I am not allowed to:

1. Use sexual language, imply or engage in sexual behaviors
2. Intimidate or frighten others
3. Embarrass or humiliate others
4. Call others names
5. Physically harm or threaten to harm others
6. Interfere with others learning or participating in school activities

The consequences of bullying will be as follows:

1. Suspension
2. Site Positive Behavior Intervention Plan
3. Site Behavior Contract
4. Recommendation for expulsion
